Why Extra Innings for Fall Ball?

The coach will be an extra innings instructor. All the Extra Innings instructors are former professional or college players. Each practice will be essentially a clinic, under the direction of an Extra Innings instructor. Our goal is to help your child become a better player, and have fun while doing it.

How much does it cost and what is included?

\$250- which includes 2 practices a week (one indoor and one outdoor), a paid coach (an EI Instructor), Full Extra Innings Uniform (shirt, pants, hat), and 10% off Pro-Shop during the fall ball season.

What age does my son sign up for?

The age cut off is May 1st 2010 and your son has to play with the age group that he will be playing for next summer. Ex. If he played 10U this past summer he will have to play 11U this fall.

If he has friends that want to sign up can they be on the same team?

If you let the staff know that signs your son up of names your son would like to play with we will do our best to keep them together.

When and Where is practice?

One, one hour practice a week will be held indoors at Extra Innings. One, one hour practice a week will be held at a field in the local area of Extra Innings. Practice schedules will be determined later. The first practices would be the week of Sept 6th.

What days and times will games be on?

Double headers will be played on Sundays September 13th to Oct 11th. Times are typically between 10 am and 4 pm. Specific times will be available the first week in September.

Where will the double headers be played?

They will be played at fields in the Northern Metro Area. We will let the players know as soon as we know specific locations and time.
